

## **Jakarta International Sixes: Damp final**

JAKARTA: It rained throughout the tournament, including towards the end of the grand final of the Apple Coal Jakarta International Sixes here in Cibubur on Sunday. GMIS and Ceylon were declared the joint winners in the final as rain stopped GMIS's run towards their maiden title.

GMIS was unlucky as they needed only 16 runs in three overs when rain stopped play. Needing 46 in five overs, GMIS were 30 without loss in two overs, with Neetesh unbeaten on 23 runs. Earlier, Ceylon had made 45/3 in five overs.

Hits and Misses placed in third position after beating tournament favorites Senayan by five wickets. H&M made 49/0 in 3.3 overs in response to Senayan's 47/3 in five overs. The Plate Final was an all Singaporean affair with Master Batters 1 beating Master Batters 2 by 13 runs.

Player of the Tournament was won by Ceylon's Dihan Silva. Master Blaster JP Le Riche of H&M was declared the best batsman and also won the most sixes award. Penang's Eki Antarai was declared the best bowler. Neetesh Pansare of GMIS won the most promising young player award," Director of Sixes tournament Avakash Lohia said.

"This year the tournament was dominated by teams from Indonesia, as all four semifinalists were local teams. Some quarterfinal games went to the wire, with one ending in a tie," said JCA President Suresh Subramanian.
