

## **India XI, WISCI and Indorama victorious**

JAKARTA: A thrilling win by India XI and expected victories from WISCI and Indorama, left the Wanderers next in line to challenge Ceylon for the top-of-the-table spot in the Apple Coal Jakarta Cricket Association (JCA) League matches played on 22 January 2012.

At Cibubur on Sunday, a hat trick (three wickets in three balls) by India XI's Dhiraj Nagpal derailed GMIS CC's run chase. After being put into bat, India XI swept to a commanding 223 in 35 overs, thanks to Subhash "Papaji" Modgil's superb 88 runs, who along with Suhail Modak (36), smashed 113 runs off the last 11 overs.

However, Junaid Rabbani took 27/4, keeping GMIS CC in the game. Needing 56 runs off 11 overs with 5 wickets in hand, GMIS CC were well on course to victory until Dhiraj took the league's first hat-trick of the season. From sitting on 168/5 after 24 overs, GMIS CC collapsed to all out for 194 after just 29.1 overs. Suhail Modak was also devastating with the ball, taking 3 wickets for 23 runs.

The WISCI Wanderers strolled to an easy 6-wickets win over KMV Tigers, with 19 overs to spare at Karawaci. William Noronha remained unbeaten on 29 and WISCI reached the target of 110 after just 16 overs. Earlier, the Tigers were all out for 109.

At Purwakarta, Indorama registered their second consecutive victory at home when they crushed GMIS XI by 8 wickets. Needing 86 to win off 35 overs, Indorama romped home with more than 19 overs to spare. Arjun Chauhan was the hero, making an unbeaten 33 with the bat, in addition to taking 5 wickets with the ball. GMIS XI's nightmare season continued, when they were bowled out for 85.
