

WISCI Wanderers thrash Indorama CC; India XI beat GMIS XI

WISCI WANDERERS and INDIA XI recorded emphatic victories over INDORAMA CC and GMIS XI respectively in the matches played on Sunday (20 November 2011) in the Apple Coal JCA League 2011-12.

At Cibubur, WISCI WANDERERS trounced INDORAMA CC by a massive 188 runs. JP Le Riche ripped through the Indorama CC batting taking 5 wickets for 20 runs. Indorama CC recorded the lowest score of the season when they were bowled out for a paltry 44 runs. Electing to bat first, the Wanderers were well placed at 94/3 in 12 overs and 155/4 in 24 overs before posting a final score of 232 runs. Captain William Noronha top-scored with 64 runs and Rajeev Rajeswaran made 38. Arjun Chauhan and R. Srikanth picked up 3 wickets each for Indorama CC.

At Karawaci, INDIA XI beat GMIS XI by 6 wickets. Half centuries by Santosh Kumar and Avakash Lohia saw India XI reach the victory target of 174 runs with 5 overs to spare. After being sent in to bat first in overcast conditions, GMIS XI made a brilliant start and were 73/1 in 10 overs before rain scuttled its progress. In a rain curtailed match of 28 overs, GMIS added 105 more runs in the next 18 overs, ending up at a competitive 173/8 in their 28 overs. TP Suraj made 44 runs and Gaurav Pathak picked up 2 wickets for 38 runs for India XI.

Bogor is at the top of the table with 48 points, followed by Ceylon and WISCI Wanderers.
